Top Tips

FAQs

Can I fundraise online?

Through Virgin Money Giving, you can set up a page for any events or fundraising you are running. It is easy to use, safe and convenient; your sponsors simply make donations online, and the money and Gift Aid will come directly to Deki.

How can I send in the money I have raised?

Pay it in online by visiting our website at deki.org.uk/donate. Here, you can make a donation using your credit or debit card. Don't forget to let us know how you raised the money in the comments box.

Pay it in by post by sending a cheque made payable to Deki Limited.

Pay it in in-person. We'd love to meet you! Feel free to drop by the office to give us a cheque or cash in person and meet the team.

Can I use the Deki logo?

As part of the Deki team you can use our logo to help promote your fundraising efforts. Contact us to find out more.

How can I claim Gift Aid on the money I raised?

If your sponsor is a UK taxpayer, the government will give Deki 25p for every £1 donated.

If you are fundraising through Virgin Money Giving, your supporters can sign up for Gift Aid by ticking the Gift Aid box when they make their donation.

If you are fundraising offline, have your friends and family tick the Gift Aid box on your Deki sponsorship form.

Please note: You can send in one cheque covering multiple donations as long as you include a copy of the sponsorship form.

If you're a UK taxpayer, using Gift Aid means that for every £1 you give, Deki can claim another 25p from HM Revenue and Customs. Gift Aid is reclaimed by Deki from the tax you pay for the current tax year. Your address is needed to identify you as a current UK taxpayer.
